Key Knowledge

- Each website has a unique, Uniform Reference Locater (URL)- otherwise known as a **domain**, which helps provide an address in order to find and locate a website on the World Wide Web (WWW).
- Each website is made up of Hypertext Markup Language (HTML) which provides the code and instructions to build the website and its content.
- Information which can be found within a website is called **content** and can take many forms e.g. writing, pictures, videos.
- You can navigate a website through the use of links, hyperlinks and webpage menus.
- Copyrighted material (©) should only be used with the explicit agreement or consent of the original owner.
- Some material can be used without the original owner's permission, but only under certain circumstances e.g. research, teaching, news reporting under a **fair use policy**.
