Key Knowledge

- When we are using 'on + verb', this can either mean 'they're' or 'let's'. We have to use context and read around the words to understand which one.
- When saying the first of the month, we use 'le premier' and when writing this, we write '1er'.
- The pronunciation of 'in' within the phrase 'j'invite...' sounds like 'on'.
- Birthday parties in France are usually held on a Wednesday afternoon because children do not attend school on a Wednesday afternoon. Sundays are reserved for family activities.
- In English we would say 'Julie's birthday', in French this is phrased as 'the birthday of Julie'. Eg, l'anniversaire de Julie.
