

Age related art vocabulary			
value	is defined as the relative lightness or darkness of a colour.	stippling	Use of dots to create light and dark (pointillism)
hatching	Spacing of parallel lines.	Blending	To gently merge two or more colours to create a gradual transition
Cross hatching	Lines crossing over the parallel lines	contour	an outline



Key Knowledge

- Value is how light or dark something is.
- When drawing something that is far away, it is often lighter in value than the other objects in the scene.
- Change value by the gap between the lines
- Change the value by the lightness / darkness of the line
- · Change the value by the thickness of the line
- The direction of lines suggests contour.
