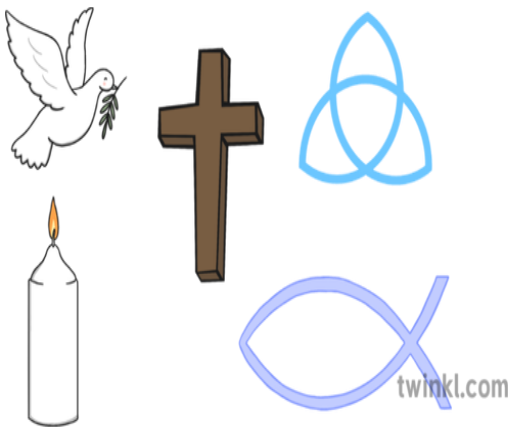



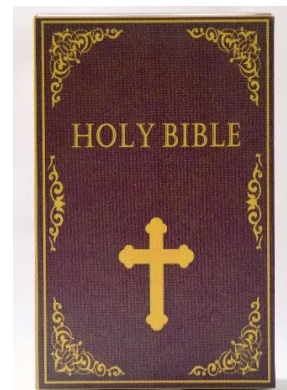

Christian	Christians are people who believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God, and who follow his teachings.	symbols	Christians use pictures or objects to give a meaning to Christian ideas.
beliefs	A belief is an opinion that a person has. Faith in God is an example of a belief.	miracle	A miracle is an extraordinary event that goes against nature, cannot be explained by science and that Christians believe is caused by God.
prayer	A way Christians speak to God especially to give thanks or to ask for something.	parable	A parable is a short story told by Jesus that teaches a moral or a spiritual lesson.
