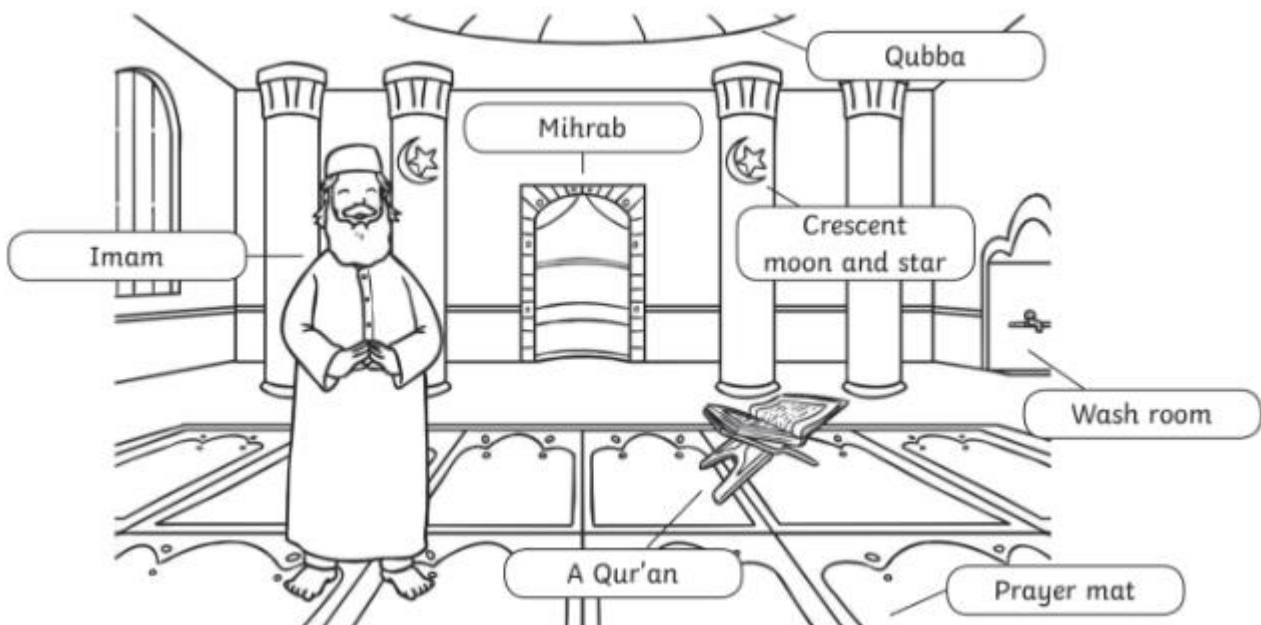

Key Knowledge

Muslims have 6 main beliefs.

1. Belief in Allah as the one and only God.
2. Belief in angels.
3. Belief in the holy books.
4. Belief in the prophets.
5. Belief in the Day of Judgement (Allah decides if a person goes to Heaven or Hell).
6. Belief in predestination (Allah has already planned out what will happen).

There are five things that Muslims are expected to do and they are called the Five Pillars of Islam. They are Shahadah, Salah, Zakat, Sawm and Hajj. Shahadah- a declaration of faith. Salah-prayer. Zakat-giving some of their earnings to charity. Sawm-fasting during the month of Ramadan. Hajj- pilgrimage to Mecca.
