Key Knowledge

A tally chart is a simple way of recording and counting frequencies. Each occurrence is shown by a tally mark and every fifth tally is drawn diagonally to make a "gate" of five. The tallies can then be counted to give the frequency.

A pictogram is a graphic symbol that conveys its meaning through its pictorial resemblance to a physical object.

Data is facts and statistics collected for reference or analysis.

An attribute is a changeable property or characteristic of some part of a program that can be set to different values.

Compare means to estimate, measure, or note the similarity or dissimilarity between two subjects.
