Key Knowledge

- When stating which fruit children like, it is best to learn the phrase 'J'aime les + noun. We turn the noun plural by using 'les', for example, 'j'aime les pommes'. In English this would work the same eg, I like apples.
- It is useful to use actions when learning how to express opinions. We can give thumbs up as we say 'j'aime' or thumbs down when we say 'je n'aime pas'.
- 'Aimes-tu...?' is a useful question stem as we can just add a fruit onto the end of this question, eg 'Aimes-tu les pommes?'
- We can use the possessive adjective 'mon' and 'ton' in this unit to build up conversation and personal preferences, eg, 'Mon' = my / ton = your.
