Focus: Why is Jesus inspiring to some people?			
Jesus	Christians believe Jesus is the son of God.	Parables	a simple story used to illustrate a moral or spiritual lesson, as told by Jesus in the Gospels.
Inspiring	A positive role-model, someone who you want to be like because of their positive actions.	Gratitude	Being and showing you are thankful.
Gospel	The teaching about Christ.	Holy week	The week before Easter, starting on Palm Sunday.
Incarnation	A God or deity in a human form.	Good Friday	The Friday before Easter Sunday, the crucifixion of Christ is commemorated.
Easter	A festival celebrating the resurrection (alive after death) of Jesus.	Maundy Thursday	the Thursday before Easter, observed in the Christian Church as a commemoration of the Last Supper.
Salvation	Being saved from harm, ruin or loss.	Easter Sunday	the day on which the festival of Easter is celebrated.

Key Knowledge

- Jesus is inspirational to many people.
- Around the world, there are about 2.18 billion **Christians**
- The Sunday before Easter is known as Palm Sunday - it celebrates Jesus' triumphal arrival in Jerusalem for Passover (a Jewish feast)
- At the last supper, Jesus took bread and drank wine with his disciples. Judas went on to betray Jesus.
- On Good Friday, Jesus was arrested, put on trial, crucified and buried in a tomb. This is the day when Christians reflect on the crucifixion of Jesus.
- Easter Sunday is a joyful day for Christians as they celebrate Jesus rising from the dead.
- In the bible, there are many different parables. These are stories that have a moral or a teaching point to give examples of how to act towards others. They try to inspire people to do good.
