Literacy

We will be...

learning the stories 'Little Charlie' and 'Billy's Beetle' by Mick Inkpen. We will be following the 'Talk 4 Writing' process: imitate, innovate and building up to the independent application of writing our own stories.

PE

During the first half term we will be learning street dance with an external coach and focusing on throwing and catching skills. In the second half term we will be doing football and yoga.

Computing

We will be...

focusing on computer systems and networks - technology around us and creating media - digital painting.

PSHE

We will be...

focusing on the theme 'Being me in my world'. We will also be learning about children's rights and creating a new class charter.

Maths

We will be...

focusing on place value within 10, addition and subtraction within 10 and 2D and 3D shapes.

DT

We will be...

designing and making a Christmas cake.

Geography

We will be...

looking at how the weather changes throughout the year and keeping a weather chart to help us answer questions about our climate.

RE

We will be...

learning about the Christian religion and the key beliefs.

History

We will be...

learning about how toys have changed within the past 100 years, looking closely at the similarities and differences.

Art

We will be...

studying the artist Barbara Hepworth and her sculptures. We will be sketching, painting and collaging her 'Family of Man' sculptures.

Science

We will be...

observing seasonal change and the weather changes that occur during Autumn. We will be working scientifically to ask questions and carry out simple tests. This will then help us to produce data and answers questions.
