Vocabulary	<u>Definition</u>
Collage	A technique of sticking lots of small pieces of a material to cover a surface.
Material	Paper, fabric, card, plastic, metal are all different types of material.
Overlap	Pieces of material are placed over the top of each other without leaving any gaps.
Rip	To pull apart a material to make uneven pieces.
Cut	To use scissors to cut pieces of a material.
PVA glue	A liquid glue which dries clear and gives a shiny finish.
Abstract	Art that doesn't represent reality but uses
Evaluate	To decide what has worked well and if there is anything you may wish to change.

What is collage?


A piece of art made by sticking various different materials together such as photographs and pieces of paper or fabric on to a backing.

The french words **papier colle** is where the word collage came from. It means pasted paper or paper cut-outs.
