

## Art Subject Knowledge Bank Year 1: Collage

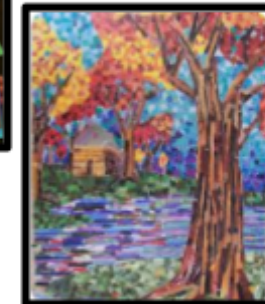
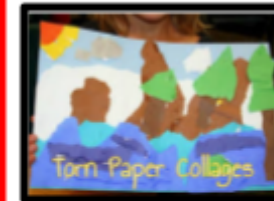
<u>Vocabulary</u>	<u>Definition</u>
<b>Collage</b>	A technique of sticking lots of small pieces of a material to cover a surface.
<b>Material</b>	Paper, fabric, card, plastic, metal are all different types of material.
<b>Overlap</b>	Pieces of material are placed over the top of each other without leaving any gaps.
<b>Rip</b>	To pull apart a material to make uneven pieces.
<b>Cut</b>	To use scissors to cut pieces of a material.
<b>PVA glue</b>	A liquid glue which dries clear and gives a shiny finish.
<b>Abstract</b>	Art that doesn't represent reality but uses
<b>Evaluate</b>	To decide what has worked well and if there is anything you may wish to change.

### What is collage?

A piece of art made by sticking various different materials together such as photographs and pieces of paper or fabric on to a backing.

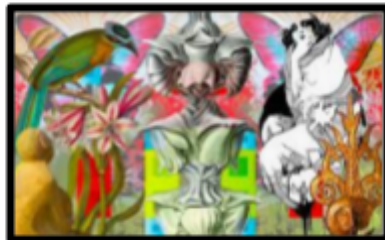
The french words **papier colle** is where the word collage came from. It means pasted paper or paper cut-outs.
