Year 1: Painting

<u>Vocabulary</u>	<u>Definition</u>
Paint	Paint is made from a coloured pigment which can be a powder, a liquid, an oil or a solid block
Watercolour Paint	A powder or block paint which is mixed with water to make an almost transparent effect
Poster paint	A bright coloured thick liquid paint.
Colour Wheel	A circle with different coloured sections used to show the relationship between primary and secondary colours.
Primary Colours	There are 3 primary colours: yellow, red and blue. They cannot be made by mixing any other colours together.
Secondary Colours	The colours that are made by mixing primary colours together: orange, purple and green.
Hues	Hue describes another word for colour The proper word to describe all the different shades of colours in a spectrum.
Evaluate	To decide what has worked well and if there is anything you may wish to change.
