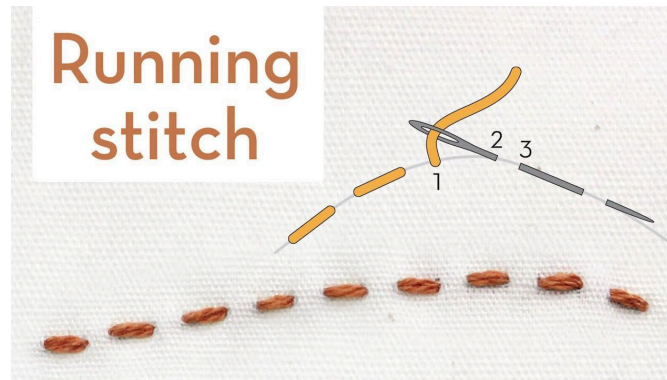

<u>Vocabulary</u>	<u>Definition</u>
Back Stitch	A series of small touching stitches.
Designer	a person who plans the look or workings of something prior to it being made, by preparing drawings or plans.
component	a part or element of a larger whole
Seam	a line where two pieces of fabric are sewn together in a garment or other article
Running Stitch	A line of small even stitches which run back and forth.

Running Stitch

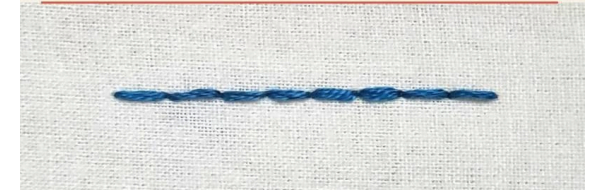
Running stitch consists of a line of small even stitches which run back and forth through the cloth without overlapping.



Back Stitch

A back stitch is a basic hand stitch where the thread is sewn in a back and forth motion. The top of the stitch looks like a series of small touching stitches while the back is overlapping.

How to make a textile item

- Choose your piece of felt
- Fold and pin in place.
- Use chalk and a ruler to mark your seams.
- Thread your needle, tie a knot and start to sew (running or back stitch)
