Year 5: Textiles

Vocabulary	Definition
Over Stitch	A stitch to make a hem or ornamental edge.
Applique	To decorate (a garment or larger piece of fabric) with pieces of fabric to form pictures or patterns.
Stuffing	padding used to stuff cushions, furniture, or soft toys.
Accurate	Be correct in all details; exact
Product	An article or substance that is manufactured or refined for sale
Sample	A small part or quantity intended to show what the whole is like

DESIGN



Produce a design for a 3D 'Stuffed' Toy. Consider:

- Textile
- 'Stuffing'
- How it is made 'inside out'
- Stitching
- Decoration

EVALUATE



- Produce annotated diagram
- Did you follow your design?
- Did you change it? / Why?
- What went well?
- What went badly?
- If you made it again how would you improve it?

- Look at a variety of textile products stuffed toy. Would they meet our design brief- Critically evaluate.
- Look at stitching, decorations, stuffing- come up with annotated drawing of the chosen product.
- Discuss the order in which the textile item would be made.

IDEA



Investigate a range of 'cuddly toys' Examine and evaluate. Examine stitching, sewing type and user. Produce annotated diagram and written evaluation.
