<u>Vocabulary</u>	<u>Definition</u>
Compass	A tool for finding direction
North, South, East, West	Points on a compass
Landmark	A feature that is important or easily recognisable
Town	A place where people live with many shops and buildings where people go to work.
Village	A small place where people live
River	A flowing stream of water that usually leads to the sea.
Bridge	A structure that allows people to cross a river or a road
Road	A piece of land you can easily travel along that connects places together
