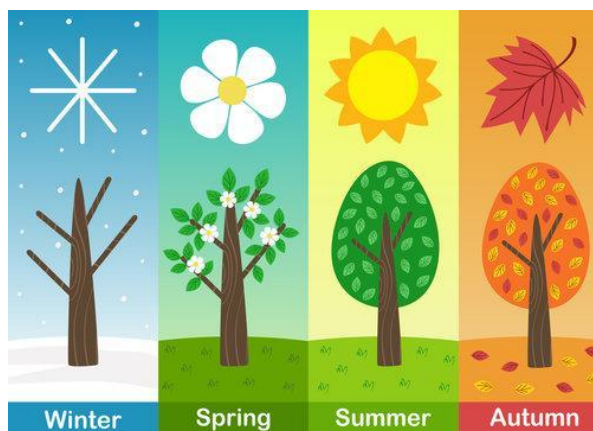

Year 1: Seasonal Change

<u>Vocabulary</u>	<u>Definition</u>
Spring	The months of March, April and May
Summer	The months of June, July and August
Autumn	The months of September, October and November
Winter	The months of December, January and February
Seasons	A period of the year that has separate weather conditions



What are the 4 seasons?

- There are four seasons in a year – Spring, Summer, Autumn and Winter.
- There are four seasons in one year.
- Spring- The months of March, April and May
- Summer- The months of June, July and August
- Autumn- The months of September, October and November
- Winter- The months of December, January and February

What is the weather like in spring?

- In spring the weather usually turns warmer, trees begin to grow their leaves, plants start to flower and young animals such as chicks and lambs are born.

What is the weather like in the summer?

- In the U.K Summer has the longest days and the highest temperatures. It is often sunny.

What is the weather like in the Autumn?

- Autumn is the time when deciduous trees shed their leaves. The weather begins to turn colder.

What is the weather like in the winter?

- In the U.K Winter is the season with the shortest days and the lowest temperatures. It can snow and be icy.
