How do geographers find out about the world?

 Geographers use research to find out about different places.

What are key parts of the world?

- There are 7 continents: Asia, Africa, North America, South America Antarctica, Europe and Australia. Each has different land types, climate and animal life.
- There are five oceans in the world: the Arctic Ocean, the Atlantic Ocean, the Indian Ocean, the Pacific Ocean and the Southern Ocean.
- UK is an Island within Europe.

What are climate zones?

- There are 3 main climates zones around the world: tropical (hot, wet), polar (cold), and temperate (mild).
- Countries near the equator tend to have a hotter climate.



What are seasons?

- In the UK the day length is the longest at mid-summer.
- Day length gets shorter at winter.
- It is usually colder and wetter during the winter and hotter in the summer.
- The weather causes changes in plants, trees and even clothing.
